

Subject: NE 58th Street Rebuild

The City's fiscal year 24/25 budget included funding for Street Rebuild Projects. City staff has identified that part of this funding be used to upgrade NE 58th Street with a new asphalt surface.

At the east end of the street construction, the street drainage will flow to new catch basin that will convey the drainage north to the Logan Creek Wetlands. The paved street cross-section will be 18 feet and along the north side of NE 58th Street a mountable curb will be constructed so that the drainage from the street will be direct to the nearest catch basin. The City has completed the design of the project and is attached for your review.

The City plans to advertise the project in June and construction could start as early as July 2025 but the contractor will be given until October 2025 to complete the project. As soon as the City receives the contractor's construction schedule, we will let you know.

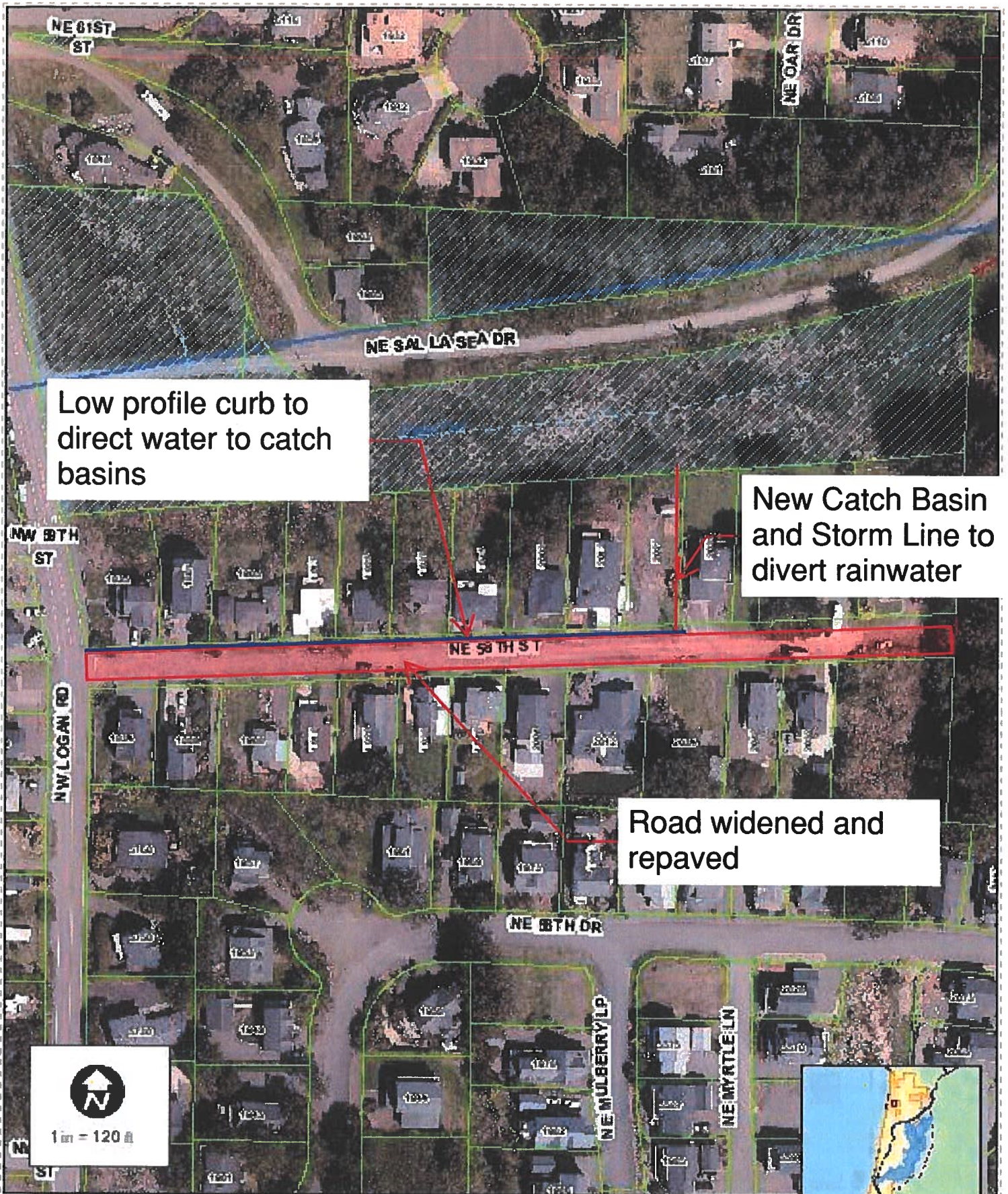
